# Wine Class

We are proud to serve a large array of wine grape varieties from all over the world. For your reference, we have notated if a wine is labeled Sustainable, Organic, Biodynamic, Natural and/or Vegan.

## **SUSTAINABLE WINE**

Sustainable wines aim to have a winemaking process that protects the environment, supports social responsibility, and maintains economic feasibility. As grapes are grown, harvested, and made into wine, a multitude of environmental factors are prioritized. This includes everything from maintaining biodiversity on vineyards to ensure soil health, to implementing recycling measures that conserve water as grapes are growing, to utilizing renewable energy technology like solar.

## **ORGANIC WINE**

Certified Organic grapes are grown without herbicides, pesticides, and chemical fertilizers applied. To take it one step further, Organic wines have no added sulfites and are made using Certified Organic grapes in a certified organic vineyard.

## **NATURAL WINE**

These are sustainable or eco-friendly wines that are cultivated and produced with a “low intervention” methodology. They utilize fewer chemicals, and most notably perform few sulfur additions (low sulfites.) While there are no assessment standards or an exact definition for ‘natural’ wine, this movement strives to showcase the wine and not the process.

## **BIODYNAMIC WINE**

The Demeter Institute (certifying organization) standard requires Certified Organic grapes with a planting and harvesting schedule, which is dictated by a biodiverse environment and moon cycles. This way, the vineyard becomes its own thriving ecosystem, which has made them known for their care of animal species and focus on the environment.

Biodynamic certification allows regulated sulfur addition levels in the wine.

## **VEGAN WINE**

Vegan wines are made without animal products (like egg whites for fining), so winemakers either leave the particles to sink naturally to the bottom of the wine, or use non-animal fining products like bentonite, a form of clay, or pea protein.
